The DEVCOM Armaments Center's Artillery Integration Facility (ARTIF) is a 10,800 sq. ft. heated facility capable of housing and maintaining a variety of artillery weapon systems.

TECHNOLOGY/FACILITY DESCRIPTION:

The ARTIF provides a central location at Picatinny Arsenal to research, develop, produce, sustain, and maintain various artillery systems and programs. Weapon systems include, but are not limited to: the M119 105mm Towed Howitzer, the M777 and M198 155mm Towed

Howitzers, the M109 155mm Self Propelled Howitzer, the D30 122mm Towed Howitzer for the Afghan National Army and other developmental weapons. These weapon systems are disassembled, assembled, calibrated and tested in this facility on a regular basis. The ARTIF was designed with a bay door on each end for drive thru capabilities, a 10 ton overhead crane so weapons can be easily loaded and unloaded from tractor trailers and a high ceiling allowing full elevation of large caliber weapons.
