DEVCOM AC Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Facility is an energetics disassembly building used primarily for the analysis of foreign ordnance.

TECHNOLOGY/FACILITY DESCRIPTION:

The EOD Facility provides functional area technical and program expertise to the U.S. Army materiel development community, Program Executive Officers and Program Managers developing munitions and other materiel systems that have explosive components requiring the employment of EOD units for their

render safe and/or disposal. The facility develops EOD procedures for U.S. Army and foreign munitions and ground weapon systems to achieve rendering safe, disposal of munitions and the safing and downloading of the weapon for further disposition. Training aids for foreign munitions are created as well. The facility is set up for both hands-on and remote energetic operations. The tools and specialized equipment utilized are certified for energetic material.
