The Homeland Defense Homeland Security Facility (HDHSF) is a multi-acre, multi-functional testing and training site that exploits the engineering expertise that is resident at Combat Capabilities Development Command Armaments Center (DEVCOM AC) to further equip our Soldiers in the war on terrorism and to leverage that same technology for the civilian needs of Homeland Security.

TECHNOLOGY/FACILITY DESCRIPTION:

The area couples Homeland Defense and Security technology development with comprehensive and integrated

training scenarios in a realistic environment. The scenarios are hands-on, dynamic and conducted under stressful conditions. HDHSF provides this environment for the joint training of Active Duty, Reserve and National Guard Soldiers as well as local, state and federal personnel. This relationship between technology development and training provides immediate end-users feedback to the developers at Picatinny thus shortening the development cycle.
