Benét Laboratories' Combat Vehicle Integration Lab is a dedicated facility established to provide space for M1 Abrams support efforts.

TECHNOLOGY/FACILITY DESCRIPTION:

This facility consists of an unconditioned 70 x 80 foot building with a large 22 x 14 foot overhead door allowing for easy access. The primary use for this building is to provide a dedicated space to store, assemble and package Abrams hardware to be utilized by the Army in the ongoing Abrams Fleet

Modernization effort. A 12 x 24 foot conditioned office space inside this lab is utilized for inspection and packaging of smaller items as well as general office work. There is no Internet access in this building. In addition to the kitting work that is performed in this building, the space is used to store various tank components that can be used for hands on inspection to aid in evaluation of Configuration Management actions.
